

# Level 2 Diploma in Health & Social Care (Adults)



## Information Sheet

### Overview

The level 2 Diploma in Health & Social Care Adult) is a vocational qualification which confirms that a candidate is competent to national standards both in underpinning knowledge and practice.

### Entry qualifications

You should be working in a care setting for at least two days per week. This should be with any adult or elderly client group.

### The Level 2 Diploma Programme

To achieve the full level 2 Diploma, learners must achieve a minimum of 46 credits, which must include 24 credits from the mandatory units in Group A and 22 credits from the optional units Group B and/or C to meet qualification combination rule. The programme is divided into classroom sessions covering knowledge units followed by workplace assessments for demonstration of competence units. Level 2 Diploma is a vocational qualification. Performance in workplace is very important and candidates should ensure that they are experienced enough to carry out required tasks unsupervised. Anyone wishing to start up a career in care is advised to attend our Skills-for-Care induction course first in order to get some voluntary experience in care setting.

### Assessment

You will be required to attend two weekend Saturday-study-days per month to cover the underpinning knowledge requirements of care. To assess your underpinning knowledge, questions and or case study will be set by the centre tutor and assessed by him/her. You will also be observed at your workplace by an assessor to assess your performance to national standards. Different forms of evidence gathering are used. Your assessor will explain these to you.

### How much will level 2 Diploma course cost?

Currently it is priced at £1395 plus awarding body registration fees. **We operate a pay as you learn system with an initial deposit of £400 and minimum £50 monthly payment.** If you are able to, you can pay all in one go.

### How long does it take to complete the course?

Level 2 Diploma is candidate led meaning that it depends on the progress made by the candidate. The course is programmed to be completed in 12 months.
